### JUNIOR COUNTY TRAINING & COUNTY TEAM SELECTION

Tennis West of Scotland organises and subsidises a county training programme for all junior age groups. A player who has demonstrated that he or she has the potential to be considered for selection to a West of Scotland age group team will be invited to join the county training programme. This will be held on indoor courts throughout the winter as it is widely recognized that, in GB, a county level player must train indoors throughout the winter on a performance surface to develop his or her skills. County training should be in addition to club training with club coaches being able to recognize the additional benefits that training in a squad of county team players can provide. Tennis Scotland recognizes the importance of county training and its performance staff are involved in the planning of the content of training sessions with the county coaching team. A very few West of Scotland players may be invited to 'regional' or 'national' training' by Tennis Scotland. This should complement club and county training but could be the only training which a player attends. Such players will be eligible to be selected for West of Scotland county teams. Where a player lives or is educated out with the county and cannot logistically attend county training, such player will be eligible to be selected for West of Scotland county teams. Such players may attend county training on an ad hoc basis. Where a player chooses not to attend county training then that player will not be considered for selection to any junior age group county team as County Cup competitions are considered an extension or end-point of the junior training programme. In exceptional circumstances, a wild card selection to a junior or adult team may be awarded to such a player with no reason required to be given for such an award. A junior player must be at least 16 years old on the day before the start of the competition to be awarded a wild card to an adult county team.
